1 AMEND House Committee Substitute for House Bill No. 303, Page 2, Section 217.196, Line 40, by
2 inserting immediately after said section and line the following:

4 "217.698. Notwithstanding any other provision of law, any person convicted of a crime that
5 was committed prior to such person attaining the age of twenty-one and sentenced on or after
6 January 1, 1976, shall be eligible for parole after:

7 (1) Serving one-third of his or her sentence that is calculated to be thirty years or less; or
8 (2) Serving a minimum of fifteen years for any sentence of imprisonment that is calculated
9 to be more than thirty years, including a sentence of life without parole."; and

11 Further amend said bill by amending the title, enacting clause, and intersectional references
12 accordingly.
