3 the following:

5 "320.091. There shall be no cause of action against any fire protection district, volunteer fire  
6 protection association, or any fire department of any political subdivision, company, or organization  
7 ~~[which]~~ that donates equipment used to suppress fire or fire protection clothing to another  
8 department, association, ~~[or]~~ district, or fire training academy if one of the following conditions  
9 ~~[are]~~ is met:

10 (1) ~~[Such equipment is approved by the state fire marshal or the state fire marshal's~~  
11 ~~designee;~~

12 ~~————(2) Motor vehicles so donated must pass a safety inspection by the Missouri state highway~~  
13 ~~patrol;~~

14 ~~————(3)] The [receiving agency demonstrates to the state fire marshal's office] recipient certifies~~  
15 ~~to the donor at the time of donation that the equipment received works properly; [and] or~~

16 ~~[(4)] (2) The donor [agency] informs the [receiving agency] recipient in writing of any~~  
17 ~~defects in the equipment or clothing about which it [knows] knew or, by using ordinary care, could~~  
18 ~~have known at the time of donation.~~

20 This immunity shall apply only to causes of action directly related to the equipment or clothing  
21 mentioned in this section."; and

23 Further amend said bill by amending the title, enacting clause, and intersectional references  
24 accordingly.
