2 No. 291, Page 12, Section 190.455, Line 8, by inserting after the word "dollar" the following:

4 " , except that in any county of the third classification with a township form of government and with more
5 than fourteen thousand but fewer than sixteen thousand inhabitants the monthly fee authorized in this section
6 shall not exceed one dollar and fifty cents.,"; and

8 Further amend said bill and section, Page 14, Line 94, by inserting "(1)" after "9."; and

10 Further amend said bill, section, and page, Line 95, by inserting the following after all of said line:

12 "(2) No county of the third classification with a township form of government and with more than
13 fourteen thousand but fewer than sixteen thousand inhabitants shall submit a proposal to the voters under this
14 section for a fee of more than one dollar until the county receives approval for the fee amount from the
15 Missouri 911 service board established under section 650.325. Once a fee of more than one dollar has been
16 approved by the Missouri 911 service board and the voters, the county shall not subsequently increase the fee
17 until the increased fee amount has been approved by the Missouri 911 service board and the voters under this
18 section. Any county of the third classification with a township form of government and with more than
19 fourteen thousand but fewer than sixteen thousand inhabitants seeking to impose or increase a fee of more
20 than one dollar shall submit to the Missouri 911 service board information to justify the fee amount. The
21 information to be provided shall include, but not be limited to, the following:

22 (a) Estimated costs of services to be provided;

23 (b) Estimated revenue from all sources intended to financially support the proposed 911 service;

24 (c) Prior revenue amounts and sources of financial support for the previously funded 911 or
25 emergency dispatch service;

26 (d) Efforts to secure revenue to support the proposed 911 service other than the proposed fee under
27 this section;

28 (e) Current level of 911 service provided and the proposed level of 911 service to be provided;

29 (f) Any previous efforts regarding the consolidation of 911 services and any currently proposed
30 efforts regarding the consolidation of 911 services; and

31 (g) Expected level of training of personnel and expected number of telecommunications per shift.,"
