1 AMEND House Committee Substitute for Senate Substitute for Senate Committee Substitute for
2 Senate Bill No. 291, Page 23, Section 488.5050, Line 21, by inserting after said section and line the
3 following:
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5 "569.086. 1. As used in this section, "critical infrastructure facility" means any of the
6 following facilities that are under construction or operational: a petroleum or alumina refinery;
7 critical electric infrastructure, as defined in 18 CFR Section 118.113(c)(3) including, but not limited
8 to, an electrical power generating facility, substation, switching station, electrical control center, or
9 electric power lines and associated equipment infrastructure; a chemical, polymer, or rubber
10 manufacturing facility; a water intake structure, water storage facility, water treatment facility,
11 wastewater treatment plant, wastewater pumping facility, or pump station; a natural gas compressor
12 station; a liquid natural gas terminal or storage facility; a telecommunications central switching
13 office; wireless telecommunications infrastructure, including cell towers, telephone poles and lines,
14 including fiber optic lines; a port, railroad switching yard, railroad tracks, trucking terminal, or other
15 freight transportation facility; a gas processing plant, including a plant used in the processing,
16 treatment, or fractionation of natural gas or natural gas liquids; a transmission facility used by a
17 federally licensed radio or television station; a steelmaking facility that uses an electric arc furnace
18 to make steel; a facility identified and regulated by the United States Department of Homeland
19 Security Chemical Facility Anti-Terrorism Standards (CFATS) program; a dam that is regulated by
20 the state or federal government; a natural gas distribution utility facility including, but not limited to,
21 natural gas distribution and transmission mains and services, pipeline interconnections, a city gate or
22 town border station, metering station, aboveground piping, a regulator station, and a natural gas
23 storage facility; a crude oil or refined products storage and distribution facility including, but not
24 limited to, valve sites, pipeline interconnection, pump station, metering station, below or
25 aboveground pipeline or piping and truck loading or offloading facility, a grain mill or processing
26 facility; a generation, transmission, or distribution system of broadband internet access; or any
27 aboveground portion of an oil, gas, hazardous liquid or chemical pipeline, tank, railroad facility, or
28 other storage facility that is enclosed by a fence, other physical barrier, or is clearly marked with
29 signs prohibiting trespassing, that are obviously designed to exclude intruders.

30 2. A person commits the offense of trespass on a critical infrastructure facility if he or she
31 unlawfully trespasses or enters property containing a critical infrastructure facility without the
32 permission of the owner of the property or lawful occupant thereof. The offense of trespass on a
33 critical infrastructure facility is a class B misdemeanor. If it is determined that the intent of the
34 trespasser is to damage, destroy, vandalize, deface, tamper with equipment, or impede or inhibit
35 operations of the facility, the person shall be guilty of a class A misdemeanor.

36 3. A person commits the offense of damage of a critical infrastructure facility if he or she

1 damages, destroys, vandalizes, defaces, or tampers with equipment in a critical infrastructure
2 facility. The offense of damage of a critical infrastructure facility is a class C felony.

3 4. If an organization is found to be a conspirator with persons who are found to have
4 committed any of the offenses set forth in subsection 2 or 3 of this section, the conspiring
5 organization shall be punished by a fine that is ten times the amount of the fine attached to the
6 offense set forth in subsection 2 or 3 of this section.

7 5. This section shall not apply to conduct protected under the Constitution of the United
8 States, the Constitution of the state of Missouri, or a state or federal law or rule."; and

10 Further amend said bill by amending the title, enacting clause, and intersectional references
11 accordingly.
