1 AMEND House Committee Substitute for Senate Substitute for Senate Committee Substitute for  
2 Senate Bill No. 291, Page 23, Section 488.5050, Line 21, by inserting after said section and line the  
3 following:

5 "650.035. 1. There is hereby created the "Missouri Law Enforcement Assistance Program"  
6 within the department of public safety.

7 2. The purpose of this program is to provide state financial and technical assistance to create  
8 or improve local law enforcement pilot programs that may include:

9 (1) Reimbursement for overtime required to enhance specialized, nonroutine training  
10 opportunities;

11 (2) Analytical capacity for targeting enforcement efforts; and

12 (3) Community policing efforts derived from research-based models.

13 3. Distribution of state funds or technical assistance shall be by contractual arrangement  
14 between the department and each recipient law enforcement agency. Terms of the contract shall be  
15 negotiable each year. The state auditor shall periodically audit all law enforcement agencies  
16 receiving state funds.

17 4. Nothing in this section shall prohibit any law enforcement agency from receiving federal  
18 or local funds should such funds become available.

19 5. All law enforcement agencies, municipal and county, located in any county [~~of the first~~  
20 ~~classification with more than one hundred fifty thousand but fewer than two hundred thousand~~  
21 ~~inhabitants, any county of the first classification with more than eighty-three thousand but fewer~~  
22 ~~than ninety-two thousand inhabitants and with a home rule city with more than seventy-six thousand~~  
23 ~~but fewer than ninety-one thousand inhabitants as the county seat, [and] any county of the third~~  
24 ~~classification without a township form of government and with more than forty-one thousand but~~  
25 ~~fewer than forty-five thousand inhabitants]~~ and in any city not within a county shall be eligible to  
26 receive funding hereunder, according to standards adopted by the department of public safety, unless  
27 otherwise restricted by statute.

28 6. No state funds shall be expended unless appropriated by the general assembly for this  
29 purpose."; and
