(1) For purposes of this section, the term "public employer" means an employer that is the state or a political subdivision of the state, including a department, agency, officer, bureau, division, board, commission, or instrumentality of the state, or a city, county, town, village, school district, or other political subdivision of the state. Subsection 3 of this section shall not apply to a public employer with respect to its employees. Any public employer that is subject to subsections 1 and 2 of this section shall continue to be subject to those subsections.

- (2) For purposes of this section, the term "private school" means any non-public school or school operated by a religious organization as defined in section 407.453 that is not a public school as defined under section 160.011. Subsection 3 of this section shall not apply to employers that are private schools, with respect to their employees. Any employer that is a private school that is subject to subsections 1 and 2 of this section shall continue to be subject to those subsections."; and
