1 AMEND House Amendment No. \_\_\_\_\_ to Senate Bill No. 358, Page 4, Line 30, by inserting after the word  
2 "adjustment." the following:

4 "217.930. 1. (1) Medical assistance under MO HealthNet shall be suspended, rather than cancelled  
5 or terminated, for a person who is an offender in a correctional center if:

6 (a) The department of social services is notified of the person's entry into the correctional center;

7 (b) On the date of entry, the person was enrolled in the MO HealthNet program; and

8 (c) The person is eligible for MO HealthNet except for institutional status.

9 (2) A suspension under this subsection shall end on the date the person is no longer an offender in a  
10 correctional center.

11 (3) Upon release from incarceration, such person shall continue to be eligible for receipt of MO  
12 HealthNet benefits until such time as the person is otherwise determined to no longer be eligible for the  
13 program.

14 2. The department of corrections shall notify the department of social services:

15 (1) Within twenty days after receiving information that a person receiving benefits under MO  
16 HealthNet is or will be an offender in a correctional center; and

17 (2) Within forty-five days prior to the release of a person who is qualified for suspension under  
18 subsection 1 of this section.

19 221.125. 1. (1) Medical assistance under MO HealthNet shall be suspended, rather than cancelled  
20 or terminated, for a person who is an offender in a county jail, a city jail, or a private jail if:

21 (a) The department of social services is notified of the person's entry into the jail;

22 (b) On the date of entry, the person was enrolled in the MO HealthNet program; and

23 (c) The person is eligible for MO HealthNet except for institutional status.

24 (2) A suspension under this subsection shall end on the date the person is no longer an offender in a  
25 jail.

26 (3) Upon release from incarceration, such person shall continue to be eligible for receipt of MO  
27 HealthNet benefits until such time as the person is otherwise determined to no longer be eligible for the  
28 program.

29 2. City, county, and private jails shall notify the department of social services within ten days after  
30 receiving information that a person receiving medical assistance under MO HealthNet is or will be an  
31 offender in the jail."; and
