## FISCAL ANALYSIS

### ASSUMPTION

#### §571.104 - Renewal of CCW permits by mail for active military members

**Oversight** notes that the **Department of Public Safety - Missouri National Guard** has stated the proposal would not have a direct fiscal impact on their organization. Oversight does not have any information to the contrary. Therefore, Oversight will reflect a zero impact on the fiscal note.

**Oversight** assumes military members with concealed carry permits will renew those permits regardless of deployment status. Therefore, Oversight assumes the provisions of this proposal will have no fiscal impact to sheriffs' departments and will reflect a zero fiscal impact for fiscal note purposes.

**Oversight** only reflects the responses that we have received from state agencies and political subdivisions; however, other sheriffs' departments were requested to respond to this proposed legislation but did not.
