ASSUMPTION

Oversight notes that the Department of Labor and Industrial Relations has stated the proposal would not have a direct fiscal impact on their organization. Oversight does not have any information to the contrary. Therefore, Oversight will reflect a zero impact on the fiscal note for this agency.

Oversight notes that the proposal could impact employee wages and therefore could impact income tax collections and earnings tax collections. However, Oversight considers this to be an indirect fiscal impact of the bill and will not reflect it on the fiscal note.
