## AN ACT

To repeal section 8.051, RSMo, and to enact in lieu thereof one new section relating to products sold in the state capitol.

---

*Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the state of Missouri, as follows:*

Section A. Section 8.051, RSMo, is repealed and one new section enacted in lieu thereof,  
2 to be known as section 8.051, to read as follows:

8.051. 1. The commissioner of administration shall establish a gift shop in the museum  
2 of the state capitol.

3 2. The commissioner shall contract with the licensing agent, as defined in section 8.700  
4 to operate the capitol gift shop, as provided in section 8.705; provided, however, that the gift  
5 shop shall be staffed by persons who are legally blind or otherwise handicapped.

6 3. At least fifty percent of the items on sale in the gift shop will be items made, on  
7 consignment, by the sheltered workshops operating within the state. "Sheltered workshops" as  
8 used in this section shall be defined as in section 178.900.

9 4. **Any nonfood item sold in the Missouri state capitol building shall be made in the**  
10 **United States. "Made in the United States", as used in this section, shall be defined as a**  
11 **product that supports a claim to be made in the United States under the policy on "Made**  
12 **in USA" claims enforced by the Federal Trade Commission.**
