AN ACT

To amend chapter 56, RSMo, by adding thereto one new section relating to prosecuting attorneys.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the state of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Chapter 56, RSMo, is amended by adding thereto one new section, to be
2 known as section 56.071, to read as follows:

3 **56.071. If a prosecuting attorney determines not to commence a case against a**
4 **person after law enforcement notifies the prosecuting attorney of a violation of state law**
5 **and there is probable cause of such violation, law enforcement may forward such case to**
6 **the attorney general's office for review. After review, if the attorney general determines**
7 **there was probable cause of a violation of state law, the attorney general may prosecute**
8 **such case.**
