AN ACT

To amend chapter 261, RSMo, by adding thereto one new section relating to the inspection of grounds or facilities used for certain agricultural purposes.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the state of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Chapter 261, RSMo, is amended by adding thereto one new section, to be known as section 261.099, to read as follows:

261.099. 1. The Missouri department of agriculture and the United States Department of Agriculture have the exclusive authority to inspect grounds or facilities that are located in Missouri and that are used for:

- (1) The production of eggs;**
- (2) The production of milk or other dairy products;**
- (3) The raising of livestock or poultry; or**
- (4) The production or raising of dogs or other animals that are not used to produce any food product.**

2. Unless specifically requested by the owner of the grounds or facilities, an individual, a corporation or other association, a governmental agency, or any other entity shall not inspect the grounds or facilities described under subsection 1 of this section to enforce or carry out the laws or administrative rules of a state other than Missouri.
