## AN ACT

To amend chapter 575, RSMo, by adding thereto one new section relating to the offense of shooting a victim while surrendering, with a penalty provision.

*Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the state of Missouri, as follows:*

Section A. Chapter 575, RSMo, is amended by adding thereto one new section, to be  
2 known as section 575.182, to read as follows:

**575.182. 1. A law enforcement officer commits the offense of shooting a victim  
2 while surrendering if the law enforcement officer shoots a victim while the victim has his  
3 or her hands raised in surrender.**

**4 2. The offense of shooting a victim while surrendering is a class A felony if the  
5 victim dies as a result of the shooting.**
