AN ACT

To amend chapter 37, RSMo, by adding thereto one new section relating to the office of administration.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the state of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Chapter 37, RSMo, is amended by adding thereto one new section, to be
2 known as section 37.960, to read as follows:

**37.960. 1. This act shall be known and may be cited as the "Million Dollar
2 Boondoggle Act of 2019".**

**3 2. As used in this section, the term "executive agency" shall mean any
4 administrative governmental entity created by the Constitution or statutes of this state
5 under the executive branch, including any department, agency, board, bureau, council,
6 commission, committee, or board of regents or board of curators of any institution of
7 higher learning supported in whole or in part by state funds; any subdivision of an
8 executive agency; and any legally designated agent of such entity.**

**9 3. The office of administration shall submit to the general assembly and post on the
10 website of the office of administration a report on each project funded by an executive
11 agency using only funds appropriated by the general assembly:**

12 (1) That is more than one year behind schedule; or

**13 (2) For which the amount spent on the project is at least one million dollars more
14 than the original cost estimate for the project.**

**15 4. To prepare the report required under subsection 3 of this section, the office of
16 administration shall send a request for information to state agencies or political
17 subdivisions no later than September first of each year and shall require a response no**

18 later than December thirty-first. The office of administration shall submit their report to
19 the general assembly and post it on their website by January thirty-first.

20 5. Each report submitted and posted under subsection 3 of this section shall, for
21 each project included in the report, provide:

22 (1) A brief description of the project, including:

23 (a) The purpose of the project;

24 (b) Each location in which the project is carried out;

25 (c) The year in which the project was initiated;

26 (d) The state's share of the total cost of the project; and

27 (e) Each primary contractor, subcontractor, grant recipient, and subgrantee
28 recipient of the project;

29 (2) An explanation of any changes to the original scope of the project, including the
30 addition or narrowing of the initial requirements of the project;

31 (3) The original expected date for completion of the project;

32 (4) The current expected date for completion of the project;

33 (5) The original cost estimate for the project, as adjusted to reflect increases in the
34 Consumer Price Index for All Urban Consumers, as published by the Bureau of Labor
35 Statistics;

36 (6) The current cost estimate for the project, as adjusted to reflect increases in the
37 Consumer Price Index for All Urban Consumers, as published by the Bureau of Labor
38 Statistics;

39 (7) An explanation for a delay in completion or increase in the original cost estimate
40 for the project; and

41 (8) The amount of and rationale for any award, incentive fee, or other type of
42 bonus, if any, awarded for the project.

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
