

HB 30 -- TRANSPORTATION DISTRICT ELECTIONS

SPONSOR: Stacy

This bill requires the circuit court to conduct transportation development district director elections in a manner similar to mail-in elections for any registered voters in a district. Registered voters will be sent a mail-in ballot with affidavit by the court after it receives voter information from an election authority. The court may conduct such elections where landowners are also eligible to vote under current law without the use of a mandatory mail-in ballot. Election days are specified in the bill and voter eligibility is determined by either land ownership or registration to vote 45 days prior to an election. If the measure passes, the election authority will provide notice to the court which has authority to authorize the formation of the transportation development district.

This bill is the same as HB 1234(2018).
