

HB 438 -- PUBLIC OFFICE AGE REQUIREMENTS

SPONSOR: Chipman

This bill lowers the minimum age requirement to 21 years for holding various county offices and special district board memberships. Included in the offices and districts affected are: county commissioner; county clerk; county assessor; county auditor; county sheriff; county coroner; county surveyor; seven-director school board; ambulance district board; emergency telephone services board; hospital district board; public water supply district board; fire protection district board; and court clerk.

The bill also reduces the filing fee from \$50 to \$25 for a candidate for county office.

This bill is the same as HB 2550 (2018).
