1 AMEND House Committee Substitute for House Bill No. 1600, Page 8, Section 115.427, Line 204,  
2 by inserting after all of said section and line the following:

4 "115.1010. 1. Voters of this state shall be entitled to vote in advance of election day,  
5 without having to state an excuse, in person or by mail for all federal or state general elections as  
6 follows:

7 (1) Early voting shall be conducted from the sixth Tuesday before the election until the  
8 close of regular business hours on the Monday immediately before the election for both in-person  
9 and mail-in voting. The hours for conducting early voting shall be the regular business hours of  
10 each election authority. For the twenty-one days immediately before election day, the hours for  
11 early voting shall also include from 11:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. on Saturday and Sunday. Beginning on  
12 the Tuesday immediately before election day, the hours for conducting early voting shall be from  
13 8:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m.

14 (2) Local election authorities shall establish early voting locations as follows:

15 (a) Each local election authority shall establish one early voting location for every three  
16 precincts within its jurisdiction. Each local election authority shall have at least one early voting  
17 location; and

18 (b) The local election authority shall ensure that the early voting locations are as centrally  
19 located as is practicable.

20 2. In determining where to locate the early voting locations, the election local authority shall  
21 consider factors including, but not limited to, the geographic location and demographics of voters in  
22 the previous federal general election, current United States census data, and the availability of  
23 suitable satellite early voting locations within the local election authority.

24 3. The election authority shall provide adequate public notice of the designated central and  
25 satellite early voting locations by posting the hours and locations for early voting at the election  
26 authority's office, on the election authority's website, and by other reasonable methods selected by  
27 the election authority.

28 4. Local election authorities shall appoint at least one election judge from each major  
29 political party to serve at the central early voting location and at any satellite early voting locations.  
30 Procedures for selecting election judges, designating election challengers, casting ballots, and  
31 tabulating ballots shall be the same as provided in general election law.

32 5. The state and all local election authorities shall make available a list of all voters who cast  
33 ballots during the early voting period. The list shall include voter information that is a matter of  
34 public record, as determined under general election law. The list shall be available in both paper  
35 and electronic format to anyone who requests a copy of the list."; and
