which shall consist of moneys appropriated to the fund by the general assembly. The commission shall
administer and disperse moneys in the fund in accordance with this section. The fund shall be a dedicated
fund and, upon appropriation, moneys in the fund shall be used solely for the administration of this sect
Notwithstanding the provisions of section 33.080, any moneys remaining in the fund at the end of the
biennium shall not revert to the credit of the general revenue fund. The state treasurer shall invest mon
the fund in the same manner as other funds are invested. Any interest and moneys earned on such
investments shall be credited to the fund.
3. An eligible veteran may elect to receive, and the commission shall issue, a monthly voucher
used to pay for room and board costs of any care facility licensed under sections 198.003 to 198.189,
