1 AMEND House Committee Substitute for Senate Committee Substitute for Senate Bill Nos. 673 &
2 560, Page 11, Section 60.570, Line 9, by inserting after all of said section and line the following:

4 "105.465. 1. Any person who registers as a lobbyist and is no longer a candidate or elected
5 official shall dissolve his or her candidate committee. In the course of dissolving such committee,
6 such person shall not disburse moneys from such committee, except for the purpose of:

7 (1) Returning a contribution made to the candidate committee to the entity responsible for
8 making the contribution to the committee;

9 (2) Donating moneys to a nonprofit entity qualified as exempt from federal taxation under
10 Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended; or

11 (3) Transferring moneys to a political party committee.

12 2. For purposes of this section, the term "lobbyist" shall have the same meaning given to
13 such term under section 105.470, and the terms "committee", "candidate committee", "contribution",
14 and "political party committee" shall have the same meanings given to such terms under section
15 130.011."; and

17 Further amend said bill by amending the title, enacting clause, and intersectional references
18 accordingly.
