1 AMEND House Committee Substitute for Senate Committee Substitute for Senate Bill Nos. 673 &
2 560, Pages 42 and 43, Section 327.091, Lines 1 to 41, by deleting all of said section and inserting in
3 lieu thereof the following:

5 "327.091. 1. [~~Any person practices as an architect in Missouri who renders or offers to~~
6 ~~render or represents himself or herself as willing or able to render service or creative work which~~
7 ~~requires architectural education, training and experience, including services and work such as~~
8 ~~consultation, evaluation, planning, aesthetic and structural design, the preparation of drawings,~~
9 ~~specifications and related documents, and the coordination of services furnished by structural, civil,~~
10 ~~mechanical and electrical engineers and other consultants as they relate to architectural work in~~
11 ~~connection with the construction or erection of any private or public building, building structure,~~
12 ~~building project or integral part or parts of buildings or of any additions or alterations thereto; or~~
13 ~~who uses the title "architect" or the terms "architect" or "architecture" or "architectural" alone or~~
14 ~~together with any words other than "landscape" that indicate or imply that such person is or holds~~
15 ~~himself or herself out to be an architect]~~ The practice of architecture is the rendering or offering to
16 render services in connection with the design and construction of public and private buildings,
17 structures and shelters, site improvements, in whole or part and including any additions or
18 alterations thereto, as well as to the spaces within and the site surrounding such buildings and
19 structures, which have as their principal purpose human occupancy or habitation. The services
20 referred to include consultation, design surveys, feasibility studies, evaluation, planning, aesthetic
21 and structural design, preliminary design, drawings, specifications, technical submissions and other
22 instruments of service, the administration of construction contracts, construction observation and
23 inspection, and the coordination of any elements of technical submissions prepared by others,
24 including professional engineers, landscape architects and other consultants that pertain to the
25 practice of architecture. A person shall be considered practicing architecture when they use the title
26 "architect" or the terms "architect" or "architecture" or "architectural" alone or together with any
27 words other than "landscape" to indicate or imply that such person is or holds himself or herself out
28 to be an architect. Only a person with the required architectural education, practical training,
29 relevant work experience, and licensure may practice as an architect in Missouri.

30 2. Architects shall be in responsible charge of all architectural design of buildings and
31 structures that can affect the health, safety, and welfare of the public within their scope of practice.";

34 Further amend said bill, Page 48, Section 327.312, Lines 1 to 23, by deleting all of said section and
35 inserting in lieu thereof the following:

1 "327.312. 1. Any person may apply to the board for enrollment as a land surveyor-in-
 2 training who is of good moral character, who is a high school graduate, or who holds a Missouri
 3 certificate of high school equivalence (GED), and either:

4 (1) Has graduated and received a baccalaureate degree in an approved curriculum as defined
 5 by board regulation which shall include at least [~~twelve~~] twenty semester hours of approved
 6 surveying course work as defined by board regulation of which at least [~~two~~] three semester hours
 7 shall be in the legal aspects of boundary surveying; or

8 (2) Has passed at least sixty hours of college credit which shall include credit for at least
 9 twenty semester hours of approved surveying course work as defined by board regulation of which
 10 at least [~~two~~] three semester hours shall be in legal aspects of boundary surveying and present
 11 evidence satisfactory to the board that in addition thereto such person has at least one year of
 12 combined professional office and field experience in land surveying projects under the immediate
 13 personal supervision of a professional land surveyor; or

14 (3) Has passed at least [~~twelve~~] twenty semester hours of approved surveying course work
 15 as defined by board regulation of which at least [~~two~~] three semester hours shall be in legal aspects
 16 of land surveying and in addition thereto has at least two years of combined professional office and
 17 field experience in land surveying projects under the immediate personal supervision of a
 18 professional land surveyor. Pursuant to this provision, not more than one year of satisfactory
 19 postsecondary education work shall count as equivalent years of satisfactory land surveying work as
 20 aforementioned.

21 2. The board shall issue a certificate of completion to each applicant who satisfies the
 22 requirements of the aforementioned land surveyor-in-training program and passes such examination
 23 or examinations as shall be required by the board."; and

 25 Further amend said bill, Page 48 and 49, Section 327.314, Lines 1 to 16, by deleting all of said
 26 section and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

 28 "327.314. Any person may apply to the board for licensure as a professional land surveyor
 29 who has been enrolled as a land surveyor-in-training and has presented evidence to the satisfaction
 30 of the board that said person has acquired at least [~~four years~~] one year of satisfactory professional
 31 field and office experience in land surveying from the date of enrollment as a land surveyor-in-
 32 training. This experience shall have been under the immediate personal supervision of a
 33 professional land surveyor."; and

 35 Further amend said bill, Page 56, Section 334.150, Line 8, by inserting after the word "state," the
 36 words "if he or she complies with the provisions of chapter 188,"; and

 38 Further amend said bill by amending the title, enacting clause, and intersectional references
 39 accordingly.
