2 Line 8, by deleting said line and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

16 Further amend said bill, page, and section, Line 16, by deleting said line and inserting in lieu thereof

19 "2. Any person who is a resident of Missouri, a resident military spouse, or a nonresident
20 military spouse and who holds a valid"; and

22 Further amend said bill and section, Page 2, Lines 21 to 27, by deleting said lines and inserting in
23 lieu thereof the following:

25 "3. The oversight body in this state shall[;]:

26 (1) Within six months of receiving an application described in subsection 2 of this section
27 from a resident of Missouri, waive any examination, educational, or experience requirements for
28 licensure in this state for the applicant if it determines that the licensing requirements in the
29 jurisdiction that issued the applicant's license are substantially similar to or more stringent than the
30 licensing requirements in Missouri for the same occupation or profession and shall issue such
31 applicant a license under this section if such applicant otherwise meets the requirements of this
32 section; or

33 (2) Within thirty days of receiving an application described in subsection 2 of this section
34 from a nonresident military spouse or a resident military spouse, waive any examination,
35 educational, or experience requirements for licensure in this state for the applicant and issue such
36 applicant a license under this section if such applicant otherwise meets the requirements of this
