1 AMEND House Committee Substitute for Senate Substitute for Senate Bill No. 644, Page 22, Section
2 376.383, Line 95, by inserting after said section and line the following:

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4 "376.687. 1. As used in this section, "prescription insulin drug" means a prescription drug that
5 contains insulin and is used to control blood glucose levels to treat diabetes, but shall not include an insulin
6 drug that is administered to a patient intravenously.

7 2. This section applies to any group or individual policy of accident and health insurance amended,
8 delivered, issued, or renewed after August 27, 2020.

9 3. An insurer that provides coverage for prescription insulin drugs pursuant to the terms of a health
10 coverage plan the insurer offers shall limit the total amount that an insured is required to pay for a thirty-day
11 supply of covered prescription insulin drugs at an amount not to exceed one hundred dollars, regardless of the
12 quantity or type of covered prescription insulin drug used to fill the insured's prescription.

13 4. Before January second of each year, the limit on the amount that an insured is required to pay for a
14 thirty-day supply of a covered prescription insulin drug shall increase by a percentage equal to the percentage
15 change from the preceding year in the medical care component of the Consumer Price Index of the Bureau of
16 Labor Statistics of the United States Department of Labor.

17 5. The director of the department of commerce and insurance may promulgate all necessary rules
18 and regulations for the administration of this section. Any rule or portion of a rule, as that term is defined in
19 section 536.010, that is created under the authority delegated in this section shall become effective only if it
20 complies with and is subject to all of the provisions of chapter 536 and, if applicable, section 536.028. This
21 section and chapter 536 are nonseverable, and if any of the powers vested with the general assembly pursuant
22 to chapter 536 to review, to delay the effective date, or to disapprove and annul a rule are subsequently held
23 unconstitutional, then the grant of rulemaking authority and any rule proposed or adopted after August 28,
24 2020, shall be invalid and void.

25 376.689. 1. Before November 2, 2020, the department of commerce and insurance, in conjunction
26 with the department of health and senior services and the department of social services, shall make available
27 to the public a report that details each department's findings for the following:

28 (1) A summary of insulin pricing practices and variables that contribute to the pricing of health
29 coverage plans;

30 (2) Public policy recommendations to control and prevent overpricing of prescription insulin drugs
31 made available to Missouri consumers; and

32 (3) Any other information that the department of commerce and insurance finds necessary.

33 2. The provisions of this section shall terminate on January 1, 2021."; and

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35 Further amend said bill by amending the title, enacting clause, and intersectional references accordingly.
