1 AMEND House Committee Substitute for Senate Substitute for Senate Bill No. 644, Page 6, Section
2 191.1160, Line 47, by inserting after all of said section and line the following:

4 "192.300. 1. The county commissions ~~[and]~~ with the advice of the county health center
5 boards of the several counties may make and promulgate orders, ordinances, rules or regulations,
6 respectively as will tend to enhance the public health and prevent the entrance of infectious,
7 contagious, communicable or dangerous diseases into such county, but any orders, ordinances, rules
8 or regulations shall not:

9 (1) Be in conflict with any rules or regulations authorized and made by the department of
10 health and senior services in accordance with this chapter or by the department of social services
11 under chapter 198; or

12 (2) Impose standards or requirements on an agricultural operation and its appurtenances, as
13 such term is defined in section 537.295, that are inconsistent with or more stringent than any
14 provision of this chapter or chapters 260, 640, 643, and 644, or any rule or regulation promulgated
15 under such chapters.

16 2. The county commissions and the county health center boards of the several counties may
17 establish reasonable fees to pay for any costs incurred in carrying out such orders, ordinances, rules
18 or regulations, however, the establishment of such fees shall not deny personal health services to
19 those individuals who are unable to pay such fees or impede the prevention or control of
20 communicable disease. Fees generated shall be deposited in the county treasury. All fees generated
21 under the provisions of this section shall be used to support the public health activities for which
22 they were generated.

23 3. After the promulgation and adoption of such orders, ordinances, rules or regulations by
24 such county commission ~~[or county health board]~~, such commission ~~[or county health board]~~ shall
25 make and enter an order or record declaring such orders, ordinances, rules or regulations to be
26 printed and available for distribution to the public in the office of the county clerk, and shall require
27 a copy of such order to be published in some newspaper in the county in three successive weeks, not
28 later than thirty days after the entry of such order, ordinance, rule or regulation.

29 4. Any person, firm, corporation or association which violates any of the orders or
30 ordinances adopted, promulgated and published by such county commission is guilty of a
31 misdemeanor and shall be prosecuted, tried and fined as otherwise provided by law. The county
32 commission ~~[or county health board]~~ of any such county has full power and authority to initiate the
33 prosecution of any action under this section."; and
