1 AMEND House Committee Substitute for Senate Substitute for Senate Bill No. 644, Page 20,  
2 Section 311.020, Line 9, by inserting after all of said section and line the following:

4 "311.199. Notwithstanding any provision of law to the contrary, a holder of a valid license  
5 to sell intoxicating liquor in the manufacturer's original package to consumers may sell such  
6 intoxicating liquor to a consumer in a container other than the manufacturer's original package,  
7 provided that:

8 (1) The intoxicating liquor is in a durable, leakproof, and sealable container that contains  
9 one or more standard bottles, pouches, or cans of malt liquor; fifty milliliters or more of spirituous  
10 liquors; or one hundred milliliters or more of wine. For purposes of this section, a "standard bottle"  
11 is any bottle, pouch, or can containing twelve ounces or less of malt liquor;

12 (2) The consumer orders and purchases a meal at the same time that the consumer purchases  
13 the intoxicating liquor;

14 (3) The holder of the license provides the consumer with a dated receipt for the purchase of  
15 the intoxicating liquor; and

16 (4) (a) The sealed alcohol container is placed in a separate one-time-use, tamperproof,  
17 transparent bag that is securely sealed; or

18 (b) The opening to the sealed alcohol container has been separately sealed with tamperproof  
19 tape."; and

21 Further amend said bill by amending the title, enacting clause, and intersectional references  
22 accordingly.
