1 AMEND House Committee Substitute for Senate Substitute No. 2 for Senate Committee Substitute
2 for Senate Bill No. 523, Page 74, Section 221.111, Line 47, by inserting after all of said section and
3 line the following:

5 "252.040. 1. No wildlife shall be pursued, taken, killed, possessed or disposed of except in
6 the manner, to the extent and at the time or times permitted by such rules and regulations; and any
7 pursuit, taking, killing, possession or disposition thereof, except as permitted by such rules and
8 regulations, are hereby prohibited. Any person violating this section shall be guilty of a
9 misdemeanor except that any person violating any of the rules and regulations pertaining to record-
10 keeping requirements imposed on licensed fur buyers and fur dealers shall be guilty of an infraction
11 and shall be fined not less than ten dollars nor more than one hundred dollars.

12 2. (1) As used in this subsection, the following terms mean:

13 (a) "Feral hog", any hog, including Russian and European wild boar, that is not
14 conspicuously identified by ear tags or other forms of identification and is roaming freely upon
15 public or private lands without the landowner's permission;

16 (b) "Landowner's agent", any person who has permission from a landowner to be present on
17 the landowner's property;

18 (c) "Nuisance animal", any armadillo, coyote, feral hog, raccoon, or skunk.

19 (2) Any landowner or such landowner's agent on such landowner's property may take,
20 attempt to take, or kill a nuisance animal on the landowner's property with the use of a night vision
21 device or a thermal imaging device."; and

23 Further amend said bill by amending the title, enacting clause, and intersectional references
