1 AMEND House Committee Substitute for Senate Bill No. 686, Page 3, Section 301.030, Line 54, by  
2 inserting after said section and line the following:

4 "301.3177. 1. Any vehicle owner may apply for "Negro Leagues Baseball Museum" license  
5 plates for any motor vehicle the person owns, either solely or jointly, other than an apportioned  
6 motor vehicle or a commercial motor vehicle licensed in excess of twenty-four thousand pounds  
7 gross weight. Upon making a ten dollar contribution to the Negro Leagues Baseball Museum, the  
8 vehicle owner may apply for the "Negro Leagues Baseball Museum" plate. If the contribution is  
9 made directly to the Negro Leagues Baseball Museum, the organization shall issue the individual  
10 making the contribution a receipt, verifying the contribution, that may be used to apply for the  
11 "Negro Leagues Baseball Museum" license plate. If the contribution is made directly to the director  
12 of revenue pursuant to section 301.3031, the director shall note the contribution and the owner may  
13 then apply for the "Negro Leagues Baseball Museum" plate. The applicant for such plate shall pay a  
14 fifteen dollar fee in addition to the regular registration fees and present any other documentation  
15 required by law for each set of "Negro Leagues Baseball Museum" plates issued pursuant to this  
16 section. Notwithstanding the provisions of section 301.144, no additional fee shall be charged for  
17 the personalization of license plates issued pursuant to this section. The "Negro Leagues Baseball  
18 Museum" plate shall bear the emblem of the Negro Leagues Baseball Museum as prescribed by the  
19 director of revenue and shall have the words "NEGRO LEAGUES BASEBALL MUSEUM". Such  
20 license plates shall be made with fully reflective material with a common color scheme and design,  
21 shall be clearly visible at night, and shall be aesthetically attractive, as prescribed by section  
22 301.130.

23 2. The director of revenue may promulgate rules and regulations for the administration of  
24 this section. Any rule or portion of a rule, as that term is defined in section 536.010, that is created  
25 under the authority delegated in this section shall become effective only if it complies with and is  
26 subject to all of the provisions of chapter 536 and, if applicable, section 536.028. This section and  
27 chapter 536 are nonseverable, and if any of the powers vested with the general assembly pursuant to  
28 chapter 536 to review, to delay the effective date, or to disapprove and annul a rule are subsequently  
29 held unconstitutional, then the grant of rulemaking authority and any rule proposed or adopted after  
30 August 28, 2020, shall be invalid and void."; and

32 Further amend said bill by amending the title, enacting clause, and intersectional references  
33 accordingly.
