1 AMEND Senate Substitute No. 3 for Senate Joint Resolution No. 38, Page 14, Section 7, Line 127,  
2 by inserting after said section and line the following:

3  
4 "Section 1. Only citizens of the United States, including occupants of soldiers' and sailors'  
5 homes, over the age of eighteen who are residents of this state are entitled to vote at any elections to  
6 the general assembly: Provided however, no person who has a guardian of his or her estate or person  
7 by reason of mental incapacity, appointed by a court of competent jurisdiction and no person who is  
8 involuntarily confined in a mental institution pursuant to an adjudication of a court of competent  
9 jurisdiction shall be entitled to vote, and persons convicted of felony, or crime connected with the  
10 exercise of the right of suffrage may be excluded by law from voting."; and

11  
12 Further amend said bill and page, Section B, Lines 1 - 11, by removing all of said section from the  
13 resolution and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

14  
15 Section B. Pursuant to chapter 116, and other applicable constitutional provisions and laws  
16 of this state allowing the general assembly to adopt ballot language for the submission of this joint  
17 resolution to the voters of this state, the official summary statement of this resolution shall be as  
18 follows:

19 "Shall the Missouri Constitution be amended to:

- 20 • Ban lobbyist gifts to legislators and their employees;  
21 • Stipulate that only citizens of the United States and Missouri residents can vote in general  
22 assembly elections; and  
23 • Create independent bipartisan citizens commissions to draw state legislative district maps  
24 equal in population, contiguous and compact, and consistent with federal law ?" and

26 Further amend said bill by amending the title, enacting clause, and intersectional references  
27 accordingly.
