1 AMEND House Committee Substitute No. 2 for House Bill No. 1604, Pages 1-4, Section 84.344,
2 Lines 1-93, by deleting said section and lines from the bill and inserting in lieu thereof the
3 following:

5 "84.348. 1. Notwithstanding the provisions of subsection 6 of section 84.344,
6 commissioned and civilian personnel who are employed by a municipal police force established in
7 section 84.344 shall not be subject, throughout their employment for a city not within a county, to a
8 residency requirement of retaining a primary residence in a city not within a county so long as the
9 primary residence is located within a one-hour response time.

10 2. Subsection 1 of this section shall not become effective unless the voters of a city not
11 within a county approve the residency requirement. The governing body of any city not within a
12 county shall submit to the voters residing within the city at the next regularly scheduled county or
13 state general, primary, or special election the question of whether to approve or reject subsection 1
14 of this section. A majority affirmative vote for approval is required for subsection 1 of this section
15 to take effect."; and

17 Further amend said bill, Page 4, Section 285.040, Line 1, by inserting immediately after the number
18 "285.040." the number "1."; and

20 Further amend said bill, page, section, and line, by inserting after the word "county" the following:
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22 ", other than commissioned and civilian personnel who are employed by a municipal police
23 force established in section 84.344,"; and
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25 Further amend said bill, page, and section, Line 2, by inserting immediately after said line the
26 following:
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28 "2. Subsection 1 of this section shall not become effective unless the voters of a city not
29 within a county approve the prohibition of a residency condition. The governing body of any city
30 not within a county shall submit to the voters residing within the city at the next regularly scheduled
31 county or state general, primary, or special election the question of whether to approve or reject
32 subsection 1 of this section. A majority affirmative vote for approval is required for subsection 1 of
33 this section to take effect."; and

35 Further amend said bill by amending the title, enacting clause, and intersectional references
36 accordingly.
