1 AMEND House Amendment No. \_\_\_\_ to House Committee Substitute for House Bill No. 1896,  
2 Page 1, Line 21, by deleting all of said line and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

4 "of section 195.855.

5 487.205. 1. As used in this section, "medical marijuana" means the use of medical  
6 marijuana in compliance with Article XIV of the Constitution of Missouri by a qualified patient  
7 with a valid medical marijuana certification in accordance with Article XIV of the Constitution of  
8 Missouri.

9 2. If a family court participant requires treatment for a qualified medical condition in  
10 accordance with Article XIV of the Constitution of Missouri, a family court shall not prohibit such  
11 participant from participating in Missouri's medical marijuana program. A family court participant  
12 shall not be required to refrain from using medical marijuana as a term or condition of successful  
13 completion of the family court program.

14 3. A family court participant that is a qualified patient with a valid medical marijuana  
15 certification in accordance with Article XIV of the Constitution of Missouri shall not be in violation  
16 of the terms or conditions of the family court on the basis of his or her participation in Missouri's  
17 medical marijuana program in accordance with Article XIV of the Constitution of Missouri.

18 4. The status and conduct of a qualified patient who acts in accordance with Article XIV of  
19 the Constitution of Missouri shall not by itself be used to restrict or abridge custodial or parental  
20 rights to minor children in any action or proceeding under the jurisdiction of family court under this  
21 chapter or juvenile court under chapter 211."; and"; and
