AN ACT

To amend chapter 191, RSMo, by adding thereto one new section relating to health care costs.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the state of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Chapter 191, RSMo, is amended by adding thereto one new section, to be known as section 191.876, to read as follows:

- 191.876. 1. Any for-profit health care provider that does not provide a good faith estimate of the cost of a particular health care service or procedure, regardless of whether such estimate is requested by the patient, and that does not obtain consent to such cost from an uninsured or self-pay patient prior to performing any nonemergency health care procedure or service that costs more than five hundred dollars per billing provider or more than one thousand dollars for the total health care procedure or service shall not charge an uninsured or self-pay patient more than the allowable Medicare amount.
- 2. Any for-profit health care provider that does not provide a good faith estimate of the cost of a particular health care service or procedure, regardless of whether such estimate is requested by the patient, and that does not obtain consent to such cost from an insured patient prior to performing any nonemergency health care procedure or service that is outside of the patient's insurance network shall not charge an insured patient more than the allowable Medicare amount.

Any nonprofit health care provider that does not provide a good faith estimate of the cost of a particular health care service or procedure, regardless of whether such estimate is requested by the patient, and that does not obtain consent to such cost from an insured patient prior to performing any none mergency health care procedure or service

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18 that is outside of the patient's insurance network shall not charge an insured patient more

- 4. A nonprofit health care provider shall not charge an uninsured or self-pay
