## AN ACT

To amend chapter 476, RSMo, by adding thereto one new section relating to the removal of certain court records from automated case management systems.

*Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the state of Missouri, as follows:*

Section A. Chapter 476, RSMo, is amended by adding thereto one new section, to be  
2 known as section 476.1025, to read as follows:

3 **476.1025. A parent, spouse, child, or personal representative of a person who was**  
4 **convicted of a misdemeanor offense may petition the court in which the person was**  
5 **convicted to have the record of such offense removed from any automated case**  
6 **management system if such person has been deceased for six months or more. Such**  
7 **petition shall be accompanied by the death certificate of the deceased person. Prior to such**  
8 **removal, the court shall determine whether any person would be unfairly prejudiced by**  
9 **having such record removed from the automated case management system.**
