

HB 1525 -- THE OFFENSE OF KEEPING A DANGEROUS DOG

SPONSOR: Shawan

Currently, a person commits the offense of keeping a dangerous dog if he or she possess a dog that has previously bitten a person or domestic animal without provocation and then bites a person again. This bill changes the offense to include a dog that has previously injured a person or domestic animal without provocation and injures a person again.

This bill is the same as HB 750 (2019).
