

HB 2050 -- COMPREHENSIVE STATE ENERGY PLAN

SPONSOR: Miller

This bill requires the Division of Energy within the Department of Natural Resources to review, by January 1, 2022, the comprehensive state energy plan and update if necessary using funding through the U.S. Department of Energy. The plan shall be reviewed biennially thereafter to ensure certain listed goals and updated as needed. The division shall use a diverse stakeholder input system either directly or by contracting with a qualified organization, and issue a report along with each review, suggesting policy changes. The division must submit the report to the Speaker of the House of Representatives and the President Pro Tem of the Senate.

This bill is the same as SB 688(2020).
