1 AMEND House Committee Substitute for House Bill No. 16, Page 1, Section 571.060, Lines 6 to 7,  
2 by deleting all of said lines and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

4 "under eighteen years of age without the consent of the recipient's custodial parent or guardian,  
5 provided that this does not prohibit the delivery of a firearm to any peace officer or member of the  
6 Armed Forces or National Guard while performing his or her official duty;"; and

8 Further amend said bill and section, Pages 1 to 2, Lines 12 to 22 by deleting all of said lines and  
9 inserting in lieu thereof the following:

11 "performing his or her official duty;

12 (4) Recklessly, as defined in section 562.016, sells, leases, [~~loans~~] lends, gives away<sub>2</sub> or  
13 delivers [~~any~~] a firearm to a person [~~less than~~] under eighteen years [~~old~~] of age without the consent  
14 of the [~~child's~~] recipient's custodial parent or guardian[~~;~~] provided[~~;~~] that this does not prohibit the  
15 delivery of [~~such weapons~~] a firearm to any peace officer or member of the Armed Forces or  
16 National Guard while performing his or her official duty; or

17 [~~(3)~~] (5) Recklessly, as defined in section 562.016, sells, leases, [~~loans~~] lends, gives away<sub>2</sub> or  
18 delivers a firearm or ammunition for a firearm to a person who is intoxicated.

19 2. Unlawful transfer of weapons under subdivision (1) or (2) of subsection 1 of this section  
20 is a class E felony; unlawful transfer of weapons under [~~subdivisions (2) and~~] subdivision (3), (4), or  
21 (5) of subsection 1 of this section is a class A misdemeanor."; and

23 Further amend said bill by amending the title, enacting clause, and intersectional references  
24 accordingly.
