AMEND House Committee Substitute for Senate Committee Substitute for Senate Bill No. 40, Page 26, Section 644.079, Line 57, by inserting after all of said section and line the following:

~~"[260.283. 1. All merchants, itinerant vendors, and peddlers doing business in this state shall have the option to provide customers either a paper or a plastic bag for the packaging of any item or good purchased, provided such purchase is of a size and manner commensurate with the use of paper and plastic bags.~~

~~2. Notwithstanding any other provision of law, no political subdivision shall impose any ban, fee, or tax upon the use of either paper or plastic bags for packaging of any item or good purchased from a merchant, itinerant vendor, or peddler. No political subdivision shall prohibit a consumer from using a reusable bag for the packaging of any item or good purchased from a merchant, itinerant vendor, or peddler.]"; and~~

Further amend said bill by amending the title, enacting clause, and intersectional references accordingly.
