1 AMEND House Committee Substitute for Senate Substitute for Senate Committee Substitute for Senate Bill  
2 Nos. 53 & 60, Page 79, Section 559.607, Line 21, by inserting after all of said line the following:

4 "565.058. 1. Any special victim as defined under section 565.002 shall not be required to reveal any  
5 current address or place of residence except to the court in camera for the purpose of determining jurisdiction  
6 and venue.

7 2. Any special victim as defined under section 565.002 may file a petition with the court alleging  
8 assault in any degree by using his or her identifying initials instead of his or her legal name if said petition  
9 alleges that he or she would be endangered by such disclosure."; and

11 Further amend said bill, Page 86, Section 574.110, Line 7, by inserting after all of said line the following:

13 "574.203. 1. Except as otherwise protected by state or federal law, a person, excluding any person  
14 who is developmentally disabled as defined in section 630.005, commits the offense of interference with a  
15 health care facility if the person willfully or recklessly interferes with a health care facility or employee of a  
16 health care facility by:

17 (1) Causing a peace disturbance while inside a health care facility;

18 (2) Refusing an order to vacate a health care facility when requested to by any employee of the  
19 health care facility;

20 (3) Threatening to inflict injury on the patients or employees, or damage to the property of a health  
21 care facility.

22 2. Hospital policies shall address incidents of workplace violence against employees, including  
23 protecting an employee from retaliation when such employee complies with hospital policies in seeking  
24 assistance or intervention from local emergency services or law enforcement when a violent incident occurs.

25 3. The offense of interference with a health care facility is a class D misdemeanor for a first offense  
26 and a class C misdemeanor for any second or subsequent offense.

27 4. As used in this section, "health care facility" means a hospital that provides health care services  
28 directly to patients.

29 574.204. 1. Except as otherwise protected by state or federal law, a person commits the offense of  
30 interference with an ambulance service if the person acts alone or in concert with others to willfully or  
31 recklessly interfere with access to or from an ambulance or willfully or recklessly disrupt any ambulance  
32 service by threatening to inflict injury on any person providing ambulance services or damage the ambulance.

33 2. The offense of interference with an ambulance service is a class D misdemeanor for a first offense  
34 and a class C misdemeanor for any second or subsequent offense."; and

36 Further amend said bill by amending the title, enacting clause, and intersectional references accordingly.
