1 AMEND House Committee Substitute for Senate Substitute for Senate Committee Substitute for  
2 Senate Bill No. 152, Page 71, Section 210.201, Line 38, by inserting after all of said section and line  
3 the following:

5 "313.300. 1. Unclaimed prize money shall be retained by the commission for the person  
6 entitled thereto for one hundred eighty days after the time at which the prize was awarded. If no  
7 claim is made for the prize within one hundred eighty days, the prize money shall be ~~reverted to the~~  
8 ~~state lottery~~ deposited into the after school programs special fund as provided in this section.

9 2. (1) There is hereby created in the state treasury the "After School Programs Special  
10 Fund", which shall consist of moneys deposited under this section. The state treasurer shall be  
11 custodian of the fund. In accordance with sections 30.170 and 30.180, the state treasurer may  
12 approve disbursements. The fund shall be a dedicated fund and, upon appropriation, moneys in the  
13 fund shall be used solely as provided in this section.

14 (2) Notwithstanding the provisions of section 33.080 to the contrary, any moneys remaining  
15 in the fund at the end of the biennium shall not revert to the credit of the general revenue fund.

16 (3) The state treasurer shall invest moneys in the fund in the same manner as other funds are  
17 invested. Any interest and moneys earned on such investments shall be credited to the fund.

18 3. Upon appropriation, moneys in the after school programs special fund shall be used to  
19 supplement, not supplant, nonlottery educational resources for after-school educational programs  
20 and purposes, and shall be distributed to eligible programs by the department of elementary and  
21 secondary education. To be eligible for any moneys distributed under this subsection, a program  
22 shall be a public or nonprofit after-school program focused on academics that serves children five  
23 years of age or older and under nineteen years of age. The department shall give priority to any  
24 program that serves geographic areas of high need as described in section 161.215 or that enrolls  
25 high-need children as described in section 162.974 if at least eighty percent of the children enrolled  
26 in the program are high-need children."; and

28 Further amend said bill by amending the title, enacting clause, and intersectional references  
29 accordingly.
