2 Senate Bill No. 43, Page 35, Section 190.200, Line 38, by inserting after all of said line and section
3 the following:

5 "191.240. 1. A health care provider shall not knowingly perform a pelvic examination on a
6 woman who is anesthetized or unconscious in a health care facility unless:

7 (1) The woman or a person authorized to make health care decisions for the woman has
8 given specific informed consent to the examination;

9 (2) The examination is necessary for diagnostic or treatment purposes; or

10 (3) A court orders the performance of the examination for the collection of evidence.

11 2. A health care provider who violates subsection 1 of this section is subject to discipline by
12 any licensing board that licenses the health care provider."; and

14 Further amend said bill by amending the title, enacting clause, and intersectional references
15 accordingly.
