AMEND House Amendment No. \_\_\_\_ to House Committee Substitute for Senate Committee  
Substitute for Senate Bill No. 403, Page 1, Line 21 by inserting after all of said line the following:

"Further amend said bill and page, Section 210.542, Line 8, by inserting after all of said line  
and section the following:

"213.145. No person's rights, privileges, or access to public services shall be denied or  
abridged solely because such person is experiencing homelessness. Such person shall be granted the  
same rights and privileges as any other citizen of this state. A person experiencing homelessness  
has the following rights:

(1) The right to move freely in public spaces, including sidewalks and public buildings,  
parks, and transportation;

(2) The right to camp in outdoor public spaces;

(3) The right to equal treatment by city and state agencies;

(4) The right to emergency medical care;

(5) The right to a reasonable expectation of privacy for personal property, just as inside a  
home;

(6) The right to vote, register to vote, and receive documentation necessary to prove  
identity; and

(7) The right to protection from disclosure of his or her record and information without  
appropriate legal authority and the right to confidentiality of personal records."; and"; and

Further amend said bill by amending the title, enacting clause, and intersectional references  
accordingly.
