FISCAL ANALYSIS

ASSUMPTION

Oversight notes the provisions of this proposal apply to counties. County officials did not respond to Oversight’s request for a statement of fiscal impact.

Oversight made several attempts to contact officials from Stone County for a request for fiscal impact but did not receive a response. Currently, Christian and Taney counties are not signed up to respond to requests for fiscal impact. Oversight will continue to contact the counties for a request and upon the receipt of their response, Oversight will review to determine if an updated fiscal note should be prepared and seek the necessary approval to publish a new fiscal note.

Oversight assumes counties are provided with core funding to handle a certain amount of activity each year. Oversight assumes counties could absorb the additional increase in meeting costs for planning commissions or board of zoning adjustment meetings related to this proposal. If multiple bills pass which require additional staffing and duties at substantial costs, counties could request funding through the annual budget requests.

No direct fiscal impact to small businesses would be expected as a result of this proposal.

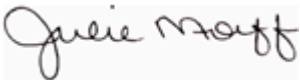
FISCAL DESCRIPTION

The proposed legislation appears to have no direct fiscal impact.


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This legislation is not federally mandated, would not duplicate any other program and would not require additional capital improvements or rental space.
