AN ACT

To repeal section 590.060, RSMo, and to enact in lieu thereof one new section relating to peace officer training.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the state of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Section 590.060, RSMo, is repealed and one new section enacted in lieu
2 thereof, to be known as section 590.060, to read as follows:

590.060. 1. The POST commission shall establish minimum standards for training
2 instructors and training centers, and the director shall establish minimum qualifications for
3 admittance into a basic training course.

4 2. The director shall license training instructors, centers, and curricula, and may probate,
5 suspend and revoke such licenses upon written notice stating the reasons for such action. Any
6 person aggrieved by a decision pursuant to this subsection may appeal as provided in chapter
7 536.

8 3. Each person seeking entrance into a basic training program shall submit a fingerprint
9 card and authorization for a criminal history background check to include the records of the
10 Federal Bureau of Investigation to the training center where such person is seeking entrance. The
11 training center shall cause a criminal history background check to be made and shall cause the
12 resulting report to be forwarded to the director. The person seeking entrance may be charged a
13 fee for the cost of this procedure.

14 **4. Notwithstanding any other provision of law, no law enforcement agency or**
15 **political subdivision empowered by law to maintain a law enforcement agency shall**
16 **contract with any public or private entity to provide law enforcement training unless the**
17 **entity's instructors and curriculum have been approved by the POST commission.**
