

HB 115 -- MISSOURI EMPLOYMENT FIRST ACT

SPONSOR: Walsh Moore (93)

This bill establishes the "Missouri Employment First Act". The bill requires all state agencies that provide employment-related services or provide services or support to persons with disabilities to coordinate with other agencies, share data where feasible, promote competitive integrated employment, and implement an employment first policy when providing services to persons with disabilities of working age. In addition, state agencies will offer specified information to all working-age persons with disabilities and to the parents or guardians of youth with a disability. The bill provides that this shall not be construed as requiring any state agency or employer to give a preference in hiring to persons with disabilities, or require a state agency to perform an action not in conformity with federal law.

This bill is the same as HB 1276 (2020) and similar to HB 517 (2019).
