

HB 392 -- COUNTY HEALTH ORDINANCES

SPONSOR: Kelley (127)

This bill provides that, during the period that a statewide emergency declared by the Governor or the legislature under Chapter 44, RSMo, exists or continues, any order, ordinance, rule or regulation made in response to the emergency by a "county health center board", as defined in the bill, will not become effective until approved by the County Commission. The order, ordinance, rule or regulation must be submitted to the County Commission for its review, and the County Commission must approve or disapprove it as soon as practicable.

This bill is similar HB 288 (2021).
