Presently Missouri Task Force 1 has two deployment regulations they have to follow. There is a state regulation that we have to use when folks are deployed for an in-state disaster and there is a federal regulation that is used when our folks are deployed for an out-of-state disaster. In some instances when there is an in-state disaster the employer delays releasing the employee. When disasters occur time is critical in saving lives. Delays can be very costly for Missourians. What we are asking for with this legislation is to use the federal regulation for all in-state and out-of-state deployments. This legislation would make us like the National Guard when they are deployed. One regulation instead of two would simplify this for all involved.
