1 AMEND House Committee Substitute for Senate Substitute No. 2 for Senate Bill No. 997, Page 13, 2 Section 37.010, Line 66, by inserting after all of the said section and line the following: 3 4 "84.480. The board of police commissioners shall appoint a chief of police who shall be the 5 chief police administrative and law enforcement officer of such cities. The chief of police shall be 6 chosen by the board solely on the basis of his or her executive and administrative qualifications and 7 his or her demonstrated knowledge of police science and administration with special reference to his 8 or her actual experience in law enforcement leadership and the provisions of section 84.420. At the 9 time of the appointment, the chief shall not be more than sixty years of age, shall have had at least 10 five years' executive experience in a governmental police agency and shall be certified by a surgeon or physician to be in a good physical condition, and shall be a citizen of the United States and shall 11 either be or become a citizen of the state of Missouri and resident of the city in which he or she is 12 13 appointed as chief of police. [In order to secure and retain the highest type of police leadership within the departments of such cities, the chief shall receive a salary of not less than eighty thousand 14 two hundred eleven dollars, nor more than one hundred eighty-nine thousand seven hundred twenty-15 16 six dollars per annum.]"; and 17
