I oppose HB 2008 for a number of reasons. I believe that, if implemented, this bill would be destructive to the public schools of the state. There are already not enough fully qualified teachers in Missouri's public schools. This bill would cause more work for teachers who are already overworked and underpaid. I think this bill would cause teachers to flee in droves from employment in our public schools—further exacerbating the teacher shortage. HB 2008 may be a bill in search of a (nonexistent) problem, but it certainly would be a bill causing a big problem.

Thank you for the opportunity to submit written testimony on House Bill 2008. The Missouri Association of School Administrators would like to go on record in opposition to HB 2008 for the following reasons: Before we relay our concerns, we would first note that we are in favor of transparency in our schools. Obviously, there are times when transparency may not be had (e.g., certain personnel matters, student discipline matters, and other matters enumerated in Chapter 610, etc.), but as a general principle, transparency in our schools fosters trust and is something every school should strive to meet. However, we are opposed to HB 2008 because the bill contains numerous vague and ambiguous provisions. The bill also contains a litany of requirements that are impractical. Indeed, by way of example, the bill requires for lesson plans to be posted for every teacher. In districts with hundreds of teachers, this would mean posting tens of thousands, if not hundreds of thousands, of lesson plans. And, it would require constant updating as lesson plans are often created in weekly intervals. As a result of these onerous requirements, much needed time will be taken from our educators that could be better used to educate students. Lastly, the bill invites mass litigation against our schools. Again, we would rather our educators deliver instruction to students than defend against needless litigation. For the reasons stated above, we ask that you please vote "No" on HB 2008.
