

In 2020 there were 311,756 active members and 345,708 inactive members in 127 state and local government retirement systems.

The Joint Committee on Public Employee Retirement is mandated by statute to study the fiscal condition of public employee retirement systems and to report its findings and recommendations annually to the General Assembly. The information the committee provides to policymakers guides future legislation regarding retirement systems for public employees.



TAX RELIEF FOR MISSOURI SENIORS AND DISABLED

The Missouri Property Tax Credit allows a credit to certain senior citizens and 100% disabled individuals based on total household income (taxable and nontaxable) and the amount of property taxes or rent paid. The credit is for a maximum of \$750 for renters and \$1,100 for those who own and occupy a home.

To be eligible a person must be:

- 65 years of age or older,
- 60 years of age or older and receiving Social Security surviving spouse benefits, or
- 100% disabled

The maximum income level to qualify:

OWNED AND OCCUPIED HOME FOR ENTIRE YEAR
 Single - \$30,000
 Married filing jointly - \$34,000
RENTERS/PART YEAR OWNERS
 Single - \$27,200
 Married filing jointly - \$29,200
