THE MISSOURI LAW ENFORCEMENT MEMORIAL



This memorial pays tribute to all the law enforcement officers who made the ultimate sacrifice by giving their lives to serve and protect the

citizens of Missouri. Plaques on the walls contain the name of the hero, his or her position, his or her city or town, and the date of death.
