

ABOUT YOUR REPRESENTATIVE

Steve Roberts was elected State Representative in 2016 to serve the people of Missouri's 77th District in the City of St. Louis. He was recently selected by his colleagues to lead as the Chair of the Missouri Legislative Black Caucus for the House and Senate. As chair, he has led the caucus in advocating for criminal justice reform, voter empowerment, and women's rights. He is currently the Ranking Member on the Special Committee on Criminal Justice. Roberts also serves on the demanding Judiciary, Utilities, and Workforce Development Committees.

Roberts, who served as a prosecutor in the City of St. Louis, has used his unique perspective to work as an advocate for criminal justice reform and economic development. Last year, he filed the Money Bail Reform Act, legislation aimed at preventing nonviolent and low-level offenders from being unnecessarily confined while awaiting trial. He also authored legislation to incentivize employers to provide full-time employment to felons seeking a second chance. In addition, Roberts helped champion legislation requiring utilities to reduce electric rates to consumers by 6.1%, as well as legislation to help pharmacies save Missourians money on prescription medications.

Roberts holds a Bachelor of Science in Communication Studies and Psychology from the University of Miami (Florida) and received his law degree from Pepperdine University School of Law (California). While in law school, his experiences included working as a legislative intern in the U.S. Congress; serving as a certified law clerk with the District Attorney's Office in the City of Compton, California; and assisting the Counsel to Secure Justice in New Delhi, India, to help victims of violent sexual assault.

After graduating law school, Roberts joined AP Wireless Infrastructure Partners, LLC, as associate in-house counsel responsible for managing over 100 million dollars of company assets. Following the 2014 events in Ferguson, Steve returned to serve his community as a prosecutor for the City of St. Louis, where he prosecuted over one hundred cases from minor weapons offenses to homicides.

He is a member of the Missouri Bar and the U.S. District Court for the Eastern District of Missouri, and served as the founder and former President of the St. Louis chapter of the National Black Prosecutor's Association. He is a lifetime member of the Mound City Bar Association and of Kappa Alpha Psi Fraternity, Inc. Roberts is also a 2nd Lieutenant serving in the Missouri Air National Guard.

**A STATEMENT FROM
THE MISSOURI LEGISLATIVE BLACK CAUCUS
ON THE KILLING OF GEORGE FLOYD AND CIVIL UNREST**

The Missouri Legislative Black Caucus decries the senseless killing of George Floyd by the Minneapolis Police Department. We express our deepest condolences to the friends and family of Mr. Floyd. His unjustified death, along with the killing of Breonna Taylor, has once again brought national attention to a pattern of police violence against African Americans that has persisted in this country and originated with the slave patrols of the South. We stand with nonviolent protesters and will focus our legislative agenda on comprehensive reform in response to police use of excessive and unnecessary force.

Peaceful protests against these killings have been a positive movement and expression of the pain and anguish of communities that will no longer tolerate inaction or the continued lack of accountability for these crimes. This is in contrast to the hijacking of these peaceful protests by those who have no regard for justice or the memory of George Floyd. In downtown St. Louis, four police officers were shot; in a separate incident, an honored and retired African American police captain, David Dorn, was killed by looters at a local pawn shop. Our thoughts and prayers are with his family as well. Small businesses, many of them African American owned and operated, have been looted and burned to the ground. This is not what we are fighting for. These actions are wrong and to be condemned. Anything less is an insult to the memory of George Floyd and the peaceful movement his death has inspired.
