

## TAX RELIEF FOR MISSOURI SENIORS AND DISABLED

**The Missouri Property Tax Credit** allows a credit to certain senior citizens and 100% disabled individuals based on total household income (taxable and nontaxable) and the amount of property taxes or rent paid. The credit is for a maximum of \$750 for renters and \$1,100 for those who own and occupy a home.

### *To be eligible a person must be:*

- 65 years of age or older,
- 60 years of age or older and receiving Social Security surviving spouse benefits, or
- 100% disabled

### *The maximum income level to qualify:*

#### **OWNED AND OCCUPIED HOME FOR ENTIRE YEAR**

Single - \$30,000

Married filing jointly - \$34,000

#### **RENTERS/PART YEAR OWNERS**

Single - \$27,500

Married filing jointly - \$29,500

## BILLS TRULY AGREED TO AND FINALLY PASSED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY THIS SESSION.

- HB 2** Appropriates money for the expenses, grants, refunds, and distributions of the State Board of Education and **Department of Elementary and Secondary Education**

- HB 34** Changes the laws regarding the **Uniform Commercial Code** to adopt the current version of Articles 1 and 7

- HB 51** Authorizes county commissions that oversee **cemetery funds** to utilize investment managers

- HB 93** Changes the laws regarding **job training**

- HB 339** Modifies provisions relating to **tort claims**
- HB 451** Specifies that a **change in population** shall not remove a city, county, or political subdivision from the operation of a law
- HB 452** Modifies definitions of "employee" and "physician employee" in actions against **health care providers** for personal injury or death
- HB 662** Changes the laws regarding the misuse of **herbicides**
- HB 850** Changes the law regarding military complaints against a commanding officer in the National Guard
- HB 1194** Prohibits political subdivisions from requiring a **minimum wage** that exceeds the requirements of state law
